第1天 新加坡 → 福冈

✕【不含餐】

第2天 福冈 ~ 太宰府 ➡ 长崎 ~ 豪斯登堡

酒店: JAL CITY 或同级

✕【午/晚餐】

•【**太宰府**】是约 1300 年前统治九州地区的官府,在长达500年的治理九州政务中发挥了重要的作用。太宰府市至今仍然保存着大宰府政厅遗址、水城遗址、观世音寺、太宰府天满宫等为数众多的历史文化古迹。

•【**豪斯登堡**】是把中世纪荷兰原封不动地搬到亚洲的“小欧洲”。本度假区内有横穿都市的美丽运河,游乐设施,博物馆,商店,饭店等。还特别因为其鲜花节和色彩缤纷王国庆典而被冠予日本三大主题之一的美名。

第3天 长崎~原爆馆~平和公园~哥拉巴公园~有明海渡轮 ➡ 熊本

酒店: NEW SKY 或同级

•【**原爆纪念馆**】1945年8月9日上午11时2分,广岛原子弹爆炸三天后,长崎市区的浦上地区也被投下了一颗原子弹,大约15万人死伤。该资料馆采用讲故事的形式,简明易懂地讲解展览了原子弹爆炸时的惨状与爆炸经过、从原爆到现在的长崎复兴情况、核武器开发史以及期盼和平、销毁核武器。对比原子弹爆炸后的惨状与现在的长崎风光照片,表现出了以惊人势头复苏的长崎市况以及长崎市民的顽强面貌。现今之世界形势,仍远未脱离原子弹爆炸与战争的威胁。在正面直视各项展品的同时,让我们了解原爆惨史,思考真正的和平。

•【**和平公园**】位于原子弹落下中心地北侧的小山丘上,它的建立饱含了绝不再发生悲惨战争的誓言和对世界和平的美好向往。这里矗立的和平祈念像,高达9.7米,右手指着天空,左手向一旁平伸,表示原爆的威胁不再世界才得以享受和平,象征了长崎市民对和平的渴望。

•【**哥拉巴公园**】1863年,托马斯布莱克·哥拉巴从遥远的苏格兰来到这里,并在南山手的山岗上建造了家园。至今已经有100多年的历史了,当年和家人在这里生活时的记忆,以及热爱长崎并在长崎生活过的商人们的宅邸仍在这里完好如初。欢迎您光顾那古老而美好的时代並和我们一起历史街道漫步一游吧。

第4天 熊本~水前寺公园 ➡ 鹿儿岛 ➡ 樱岛 ➡ 鹿儿岛~砂蒸温泉 ➡ 指宿

酒店: IWASAKI温泉 或同级

•【**水前寺公园**】正式名称称作“水前寺成趣园”,是17世纪30年代由熊本藩主细川忠利历经3代建造的庭园,已被指定为国家名胜史迹。据说模仿东海道五十三驿的庭园内,以阿苏山潜流水涌出的水池为中心,建有仿造富士山的假山、1912年从京都御所移建的茅草屋“古今传授间”等,据说从“古今传授间”观赏的成趣园风景最为出色。

•【**樱岛**】距鹿儿岛市中心约4公里,由别名锦江湾的鹿儿岛湾内火山喷发形成,称得上是鹿儿岛的象征。鹿儿岛港至樱岛搭乘渡轮只需15分钟就可以抵达。樱岛是世界上不多见的活火山,有史以来反复多次大爆发,本来是个孤岛,1914年大爆发时,与大隅半岛的陆地连接了起来。此外,有村熔岩瞭望台的动态景观也很吸引人。所有这些瞭望观察设施配套完善。

•【**体验砂蒸温泉**】指宿温泉最著名的温泉,除了全世界独一无二的「砂蒸温泉」之外不作他想。鹿儿岛有著被地底温泉的热气加热过的沙滩,而所谓的「砂蒸温泉」,便是一种将身体埋进这种沙滩裡享受的独特温泉,舒适的热气及适当的砂压能够促进排汗,具有排毒效果。

第5天 指宿~城山展望台~仙巖园 ➡ 阿苏~草千里

•【**城山展望台**】位于107米的小山上,鹿儿岛市中心尽收眼底,还能一览锦江湾、樱岛。

•【**仙巖园**】瞭望活火山「樱岛」的最美庭园,最佳表达日本传统文化之庭园也就是「仙巖园」。依照日本悠美筑庭技法造园、依山畔水风水地理特佳、在园内各处可远望海湾之外、正面呈现著最景观活火山「樱岛」的庭园。

•【**草千里**】宽径东西18公里、南北长达24公里的巨火山口周围被外轮山环抱,景观壮丽。位在火山口内乌帽子岳,山麓内广阔的草原称作“草千里之滨”,随处可看见放牧牛羊马群的景色。

第6天 阿苏 ➡ 大分县~汤布院民艺村~日田札幌啤酒新工厂 ➡ 福冈~中洲商区

•【**汤布院民艺村**】是把富有历史的住宅和酒窖等的建筑物移建再作为展示古老的民艺品和陶瓷器的设施。有收集和展览17世纪至19世纪期间的民艺品。

•【**中洲商区**】是夹在那珂川和博多川之间的九州地区最大的闹市。云集于中洲的约 3500 家饮食店和排列在那珂川沿岸的摊档,再加上博多河畔城等大型综合商店,构成了一幅商业繁荣的景象。

DAY 2 FUKUOKA~Dazaifu ㊦ NAGASAKI~Huis Ten Bosch

• **[Dazaifu City]** Today's Dazaifu City owes its name to an office called the Dazaifu or "Government-General Headquarters," which was established here approximately 1300 years ago and which rules all of Kyushu for a period of some 500 years.

• **[Huis Ten Bosch]** It is a "small Europe" which models Holland in the Middle Ages with beautiful canal. Attractions, museums, shops, restaurants and hotels etc. and is especially known as one of the biggest theme parks in Japan for its Flower Festival.

DAY 3 NAGASAKI ~ Atomic Bomb Museum ~ Peace Park ~ Glover Garden ~ Ariake Ferry ㊦ KUMAMOTO

• **[Atomic Bomb Museum]** At 11:02 a.m. on August 9, 1945, the B-29 bomber dropped an atomic bomb on Nagasaki, just three days after the first attack on Hiroshima. The survivors still suffer extensively from the mental and physical damage of the atomic bomb. The museum exhibits extensive materials on the actual bombing and latest nuclear weapons, aiming to contribute to the abolition of nuclear weapons and the realization of lasting world peace.

• **[Peace Park]** Is built on a low hill to the north of the hypocenter of the atomic bomb blast. It was created to represent the wish for world peace and a vow that such a tragic war would never be repeated. The park features the 9.7-meter-high Peace Statue symbolizing the Nagasaki citizens' wish for peace.

• **[Glover Garden]** Thomas Blake Glover, who travelled across the sea from distant Scotland, built his home here on Minami-Yamate hill in 1863. More than a century later, mementoes of when the Glover family lived here survive unchanged, along with the residences of the traders who loved Nagasaki and made their homes here. Welcome to the good old days. Let's join the Glovers for a stroll through their romantic history.

DAY 4 KUMAMOTO ~ Suizenji Jojuen Park ㊦ Kagoshima ㊦ Sakurajima ㊦ Kagoshima ~ Hot Sand Bath ㊦ IBUSUKI

• **[Suizenji Jojuen Park]** It is a traditional Japanese garden landscaped around a natural spring pond. The area was originally the site of Suizenji temple, later, Lord Tsunatoshi built the garden around the temple into its current form. The placement of the pond, trees, and hills were supposedly meant to represent parts of the 53 Stations of the Tokaido.

• **[Sakurajima]** Kagoshima's symbolic Sakurajima is a volcanic island, which floats in the sea only 4km from South Kyushu's hub city, Kagoshima. It is one of the world's greatest active volcanoes. In a major eruption in 1914, lava filled a 400-meter wide strait causing the island to connect with Osumi Peninsula on the opposite shore. Approximately 10 billion ton of lava, a volume without parallel in the world, flowed out.

• **[Hot Sand Bath]** Ibusuki Onsen is famous for the hot sand baths, which are found almost nowhere else on earth. It is a unique hot spring in which you are buried in a sand beach that is warmed by the heat of underground hot springs. The comfortable heat and gentle pressure from the sand cause perspiration, which has a detoxing effect.

DAY 5 IBUSUKI ~ Shiroyama Observatory ~ Sengan-en Garden ㊦ ASO ~ Kusasenri

• **[Shiroyama Observatory]** Located at an altitude of 107m, it commands a view of downtown Kagoshima, Sakurajima volcano & Kinko Bay.

• **[Sengan-en Garden]** is a Japanese-style landscape garden along the coast of downtown Kagoshima. One of its most striking features is its use of Sakurajima and Kagoshima Bay as borrowed scenery.

• **[Kusasenri]** is a prairie with a beautiful view of the smoking Mt. Naka. This prairie is a large quadrangular grassy plain, which spreads out at the northern foot of Mt. Eboshi. A big pond at its center and grazing horses round about make an idyllic scene.

DAY 6 ASO ㊦ QITA ~ Yufuin Folk Craft Village ~ Sapporo Beer Hita Factory ㊦ FUKUOKA ~ Nakasu

• **[Yufuin Folk Craft Village]** is equipped with a collection of crafts from the end of Edo to early Meiji period, a handmade Japanese paper studio, demonstrations in indigo-dyeing, glass blowing, pottery & washi paper manufacture by local artists in historic buildings re-assembled at the site.

• **[Nakasau]** is the busiest street on Kyushu, where about 3500 restaurants stand close together, street stalls line the Naka-gawa River, and large-scale shopping centers, cooperate with each other to produce the din and bustle of the amusement district.
